An unofficial Texas A&M University transcript is a comprehensive advising record of a student's academic progress at Texas A&M University*. In other words, a student's official Texas A&M University transcripts includes academic credit awarded to the student at all levels of study (undergraduate, graduate, and professional), detailed transfer credit from other institutions awarded to the student, and curriculum of study by term information.* Students of the Law School who enrolled during the fall 2013 semester and beyond may obtain an unofficial Texas A&M University transcript containing their professional law school level academic history included. Former students of the Law School who were enrolled prior to the fall 2013 semester, while it operated under Texas Wesleyan School of Law, will need to request an unofficial transcript from theTexas Wesleyan University's Registrar's Office.Students of the Health Science Center (HSC) may obtain an unofficial Texas A&M University transcript containing their HSC academic history included. Note: Undergraduate and Graduate records are generated as separate transcripts. Students who wish to have a complete transcript record for an in-progress term should indicate Hold for Grades or Hold for Degree at the time of order. Please note that the Office of the Registrar will hold these transcripts until official grading for the term and related processes are completed. Generally, this is 5 business days following the grading deadline. Missing grades, degrees, or other term-related information will not justify resending a transcript at no charge at a later date if Hold for Grades or Hold for Degree was not indicated. To insure receiving a transcript with all grades and degrees posted, please log on to Raiderlink and notify your college dean's office of any missing information prior to ordering the transcript. Payment must be made at the time of order via credit or debit card (no cash or checks). Hold for pickup orders will be retained for 10 business days following printing (including hold for grades and degrees), after which the transcript will be destroyed and a new order and payment will be required. Orders with transcript holds will be cancelled after 2 business days if the hold has not been resolved. A credit will be issued to the Parchment account. Orders for transcripts during a student's first semester attendance will not be released until final grades have been awarded for the term. An official transcript will not be issued unless all financial obligations to the University have been satisfied. Official Transcripts will not be faxed. All transcript orders will be reviewed for holds and audited to insure accuracy. Depending upon the time of year, expect a minimum fulfillment time of 1 to 3 business days. Current students or those with an active eRaider account should complete and submit a Transcript Request Form. Current Law students and alumni who matriculated in Fall 2012 or later may download a PDF of your unofficial transcript through your Dashboard Courses page. Alumni who matriculated prior to Fall 2012 and anyone who would like an unofficial transcript mailed to you will need to submit an official request form. If you do not know your UT EID, you may download and submit a Texas Law Official Request Form (without UT EID) to registration@law.utexas.edu. To change the Preferred Name on your unofficial transcript, update the Law School Name and Email section of All My Addresses. To change your official student name with the university, instructions to Make a Legal Name Change can be found on Texas One Stop Personal Information. If you need an official transcript, you must purchase it through Texas One Stop. Note that official transcript requests for Law Students received at the end of a semester are not processed by Texas One Stop until after the grading deadline for each term. Because of this delay, we encourage you to check your online grade report for final grade posting before ordering an official transcript.
