

## **Casting vampire academy**

Adapted from a book series written by Richelle Mead, Vampire Academy is a supernatural drama that includes a massive roster of characters - here is everything we know about the cast members who play them. Vampire Academy was first traversed to the big screen in 2014, but the movie was unfortunately a box office failure. Its young adult vampire storylines later caught Julie Plec's attention, who collaborated with Marguerite MacIntyre (writer of The Vampire Diaries' spin-off, The Originals) to adapt it into a full-fledged TV series. As Vampire Academy's title suggests, its drama ensues in the backdrop of a vampire boarding school named St. Vladimir's Academy. A guardian-in-training Dhampir named Rosemarie "Rose" Hathaway and Moroi princess Vasilisa "Lissa" Dragomir are among the many young vampires who join the academy to hone their abilities and learn more about their place in the vampire class hierarchy. With each episode, as Rose and Lissa break their divides and become friends, they delve deeper into the forbidden relationships and class divides that surround them. Since Peacock's Vampire Academy is rife with political undertones and complex relationships, it is not surprising that it has a talented team of cast members led by Sisi Stringer and Daniela Nieves. On that premise, here is everything else we know about the cast and characters of Peacock's Vampire Academy. Sisi Stringer As Rose Hathaway Among the three types of vampires existing in the Vampire Academy universe — Moroi, Damphir, and Strigoi — Rose belongs to the Damphir class. She is the only child of an infamous Moroi named Ibrahim 'Abe' Mazur and renowned Guardian Janine Hathaway. At the academy, she befriends Lissa, and they set out on many supernatural adventures. Vampire Academy star Sisi Stringer is best known for playing Mileena in Mortal Kombat (2021). Lissa, the daughter of Eric Dragomir, is Rose's best friend. She is a Moroi and has the rare element of spirit that allows her to immediately others heal and even restore life. After a series of events, she also becomes the Queen of the Moroi Court. Daniela Nieves, who plays Lissa in Vampire Academy, has previously played the recurring role of Andi Cruz in Every Witch Way and WITS Academy. She also appears as Juana in FX's Snowfall. Kieron Morre, also known for playing Crispin in Netflix's The Sandman and Dylan in Sex Education, takes the role of Guardian Dimitri in Vampire Academy. Dimitri is a famous Damphir guardian who ends up serving Oueen Lissa's partner, Christian Ozera. After being Rose's mentor for a while, he starts dating her even though their relationship is considered forbidden in their world. André Dae Kim has over twenty acting credits under his belt, with Netflix's Locke & Key and Paramount +'s Star Trek: Strange New Worlds being among them. The actor plays the role of Christian Ozera in Vampires of his class as they suspect that he too, will follow the same path. Despite all this, Lissa accepts him for who he is and later even dates him in Peacock's Vampire Academy. Craig Stevenson is another prominent royal Morio named Dane in Vampire Academy. Jennifer Kirby as Alberta Casey: With acting credits in shows like Endeavour, Call the Midwife, and Children in Need, Jennifer Kirby can be spotted in eight Vampire Academy TV show, has more credits on her resume. The Venezeula-born actress is known for playing Andi on the Nickelodeon series Every Witch Way and WITS Academy (Nieves is the actress on the right in the WITS Academy image above). The 24-year-old has also appeared in TV series like Snowfall, Save Me, All Rise, and Five Points. In Vampire Academy, Nieves will play Lissa, a Royal Moroi vampire who is the younger sister to the heir apparent. When a sudden death rocks her family, Lissa will be thrust into a role she never trained for and didn't ask her. Kieron Moore will star as Dimitri Belikov, a Russian dhampir and guardian who also serves as Rose's primary love interest. While Moore did have a minor role in Sex Education, the only three roles on his IMDB page are for Masters of the Air, Emmerdale Farm and Birthday Girl. André Dae Kim will play Christian Ozera, an intelligent and thoughtful Royal Moroi vampire who's a pariah due to his parents' unforgivable societal sins. Kim is a Canadian actor who appeared in Degrassi: The Next Generation and Degrassi: Next Class as Winston Chu, and in the CBS sci-fi series Salvation as recurring character Dylan Edwards. Longtime TV genre actor J. August Richards will be playing the Moroi noble vampire Victor Dashkov. Highly regarded for his role as vampire hunter hunter (awkward) Gunn on Angel, as well as for playing Mike Peterson/Deathlock on Agents of SHIELD. British actress Anita-Joy Uwajeh will play Tatiana Vogel, a Moroi vampire and political underdog who slowly takes the royal court by storm. Uqajeh is best known for her theater work. The just-announced cast also includes J. August Richards, Daniela Nieves, Andre Dae Kim, Anita-Joy Uwajeh, Mia McKenna-Bruce, Rhian Blundell, Jonetta Kaiser, and Andrew Liner. Julie Plec and Marguerite MacIntyre created the series and are writing, executive producing, and serving as showrunners. Plec, who's previously sunk her teeth into The Vampire Diaries, The Originals, and Legacies, will also direct an unknown number of episodes during the series' first season. Additional executive producers include Emily Cummins, Don Murphy, Susan Montford, Deepak Nayar and Jillian DeFrehn. SERIES REGULARS: SISI STRINGER will play Rose Hathaway, a vampire-human hybrid known as a Dhampir. Fiery and outspoken, Rose is a true fighter in spirit and in practice. She always jumps into action, and more often than not, this results in demerits. She might be the strongest fighter in her class, but her success will depend entirely on her willingness to toe the line when it counts. DANIELA NIEVES (Sex Appeal, Five Points) will play Lissa Dragomir, a Royal Moroi vampire. Growing up the younger sister to the heir apparent, Princess Vasilisa Dragomir is a carefree, kind-hearted, royal princess coasting through her studies and happily chasing fun. Lissa is uninterested in the political machinations of the Royal Court or the hypocrisy of Moroi royal society. But with a sudden death in her family, Lissa is thrust into a role she's neither trained for nor is emotionally equipped to handle. KIERON MOORE will play Dimitri Belikov, the model of a Dhampir guardian: lethal, disciplined, discreet, and totally committed to his role as bodyguard to the ruling Moroi, the "good," mortal vampires of his world. He lives by a deep moral code, but beneath his stoic, watchful surface, there's an expansive spirit that could threaten to expose the underlying tension between his sense of what's right and his formal duty to the Moroi. ANDRÉ DAE KIM (Star Trek: Strange New Worlds) will play Christian Ozera, a Royal Moroi vampire. Intelligent and thoughtful, Christian is the pariah of the school and royal court, due to his parents' unforgiveable societal sins. Well-read and hungry for knowledge, he searches for faith-based answers and discovers a kindred spirit who is also looking for the truth. J. AUGUST RICHARDS (Angel) will play Victor Dashkov. Victor is a Moroi dignitaries. He's a fierce loyalist who uses his intelligence and influence to protect that which he values most: the well-being of his husband and two adopted daughters, as well as the betterment of his Moroi community. ANITA-JOY UWAJEH (West End's Cyrano de Bergerac and King Lear), will play Tatiana vogel. Tatiana is a Moroi vampire and political underdog who slowly takes the royal court by storm. Motivated by love and a sense of justice, Tatiana has a unique skill of making herself seem of no consequence until we realize much too late that she was always the one to watch. MIA MCKENNA-BRUCE (The Dumping Ground) will play Mia Karp, a student at St. Vladimir's Academy. Witty, cutting, and just the right kind of ruthless when necessary, non-Royal Mia has a long-term plan to social climb her way into the ranks of royalty, with all the privilege and freedom that entails. A plan complicated by her instant chemistry with Meredith, a Smart, strong-willed Dhampir who is a keen observer, which makes her an excellent strategist and a valuable asset. She has little patience for Rose's volatility or Mia's elitism, and regularly calls both of them out. JONETTA KAISER (Breakwater) will play Sonya is not of royal bloodline and sits out on the fringe of Moroi society, preferring to spend her time in the library or her gardens. Not a person who likes a scene, nonetheless she has a quiet but profound power of her own. She is taken by surprise when a Dhampir Guardian named Mikhail shows interest in her, a relationship that will expose both the brightest and darkest parts of her heart. ANDREW LINER (Grown-ish) will play Mason Ashford. Charming loyal and popular, Mason is Rose's main competition in the quest to become the number one Guardian-in-training. With its original release from September 15 to October 27, 2022, Vampire Academy was an excellent welcoming for the 2022 Halloween. Developed by Julie Plec and Marguerite MacIntyre for Peacock, the series was based on Richelle Mead's six young-adult paranormal romance novels published from 2007 to 2010. Although it isn't the first on-screen adaptation of the novel (a 2014 film was released with the same name), the series took a unique approach in adapting all six novel series. Besides enjoying mostly positive reviews from the book fans and series audiences, it pulled together an amazing ensemble cast. Sadly, despite season 1's cliffhangers, the series was canceled by Peacock. Here's a look at the ensemble cast. involved with. Sisi Stringer as Rose Hathaway Rose Hathaway is the book and Vampire Academy series' main protagonist. She's a Dhampir guardian in training. She's a Dhampir guardian in training. She's also Lissa Dragomir's best friend. At a point in the series, she becomes conflicted about staying as Lissa's guardian or being a best friend. At a point in the series is Dimitri Belikov. Actress Sisi Stringer was cast as Rose Hathaway in the Vampire Academy TV series. Before her time on the show, Stringer appeared in Robert Connolly's thriller Force of Nature: The Dry 2 (2023) as Beth. Stringer also has an upcoming movie, Mammon: Hell on Earth, where she'll play the character Estry. Daniela Nieves as Lissa Dragomir is the series' next most important character. She's a royal Moroi princess who was made Queen before the Queen's death. However, her claim to the throne is being challenged by Tatiana Vogel. Lissa is also Rose Hathaway's best friend, whose love interest is Christian Ozera. Lissa is a spirit user and has healing powers. She's also Andre Dragomir's sister. Venezuelan-American actress Daniela Nieves became popular, starring in several teen series. She played Andrea "Andi" Cruz in Nickelodeon's Every Witch Way (2014-2015), reprised the role in the spin-off WITS Academy (2015), and played Ananda in Five Points (2018). Besides making her film debut in 2022 by playing Lyssa in Sex Appeal (2022), Nieves does not currently have an active project she's working on. Kieron Moore as Dimitri Belikov Kieron Moore's character Dimitri Belikov is a top Dhampir guardian. Kept in the dungeon for treason, Dimitri is released to help fight off the Strigoi invading the city. The character is also Rose Hathaway's love interest. The English television actor made his debut in 2019 and made guest appearances in Sex Education (2021) and The Sandman (2022). After the cancellation of Vampire Academy, fans can watch Moore in the Apple TV+ war drama miniseries Masters of the Air (2023). André Dae Kim as Christian Ozera is a fire user and one of the strongest royal Moroi vampires. He's also Lissa Dragomir's love interest. Canadian actor André Dae Kim was cast as Christian Ozera in Vampire Academy. Dae Kim's professional acting career began in 2013 when he was cast as Winston Chu in the teen drama series Degrassi: The Next Generation (2013-2015). He also appeared as Chief Kyle in Star Trek: Strange New Worlds in 2022. He currently doesn't have a new acting project he's working on. Anita-Joy Uwajeh as Tatiana Vogel Tatiana Vogel is a royal Moroi vampire and part of the royal council. She's one of Vampire Academy's antagonists. Although a political underdog, she orchestrated the death of the Queen and is looking to challenge Lissa Dragomir's claim to the throne. Anita-Joy Uwajeh, who played Tatiana, doesn't currently have a project she's cast in. However, she was also known for her recurring role in Lucky Man (2016) and live stage performances in National Theater Live: Cyrano de Bergerac (2019). J. August Richards as Victor Dashkov American actor J. August Richards played the royal Moroi vampire Victor Dashkov. He's a prominent member of the royal council and a key advisor to the Queen. As such, he's Lissa Dragomir's legal guardian and godfather. Victor is also the father of Sonya Karp and the husband of Robert Karp. August Richards is one of the more established actors in Vampire Academy. He played Sherman in the 1998 romantic drama Why Do Fools Fall in Love. His most prominent television roles include playing Charles Gunn in Angel (2000-2004), A.D.A. Billy Desmond in Conviction (2006), and Marcus McGrath in Raising the Bar (2008-2009). Others are Bradley Gregorian in Notorious (2016), Deputy Nathan Purcell in Kevin (Probably) Saves the World (2017-2018), Dr. Oliver Post in Council of Dads (2020), and Joe in Generation (2021). Mia McKenna-Bruce as Mia Karp English actress Mia Marp in the Vampire. Meredith Beckham's is her love interest. Besides being Sonya's adoptive sister, she's also the adopted daughter of Victor Dashkov and Robert Karp. McKenna-Bruce starred in Netflix's period romantic movie Persuasion (2022). In television, she played Tee Taylor in Tracy Beaker Returns (2010-2012) and reprised the role in The Dumping Ground TV series. In 2023, she starred in Kindling and the British drama How To Have Sex. Jonetta Kaiser as Sonya Karp Sonya Karp is also a non-royal Moroi vampire and an adoptive sister of Mia. She was turned willingly into a Strigoi to escape the coming darkness. Mia is also a secret spirit user and Mikhail Tanner's former girlfriend. American actress Jonetta Kaiser played Sonya. The actress is known for playing Heather in Two Sides (2019) and Kara in Breakwater (2022). In 2022, she also starred in Root Letter and A Party to Die For. Pik-Sen Lim as Queen Marina Malaysian-British actress Pik-Sen Lim being the 200-year-old Queen of the Dominion. A royal Moroi vampire, Queen Marina is an air user. Understanding the plot to assassinate her

Queen Marina hurriedly makes Lissa Dragomir Queen. Pik-Sen Lim is British television's most popular actress of the 70s and 80s. In recent times, she started in Johnny English Reborn (2011), Roald Dahl's Esio Trot (2015), and This Way Up (2019).
